### **Project Advisor: Young Adults & Conflict Resolution**

#### **Six Rivers Dispute Resolution Center**

Six Rivers is a non-profit dispute resolution center serving the Mid-Columbia region. It provides low- cost conflict resolution and education services. Six Rivers' mediators and facilitators are highly trained community volunteers dedicated to helping people solve problems and resolve conflict. Six Rivers strives to create positive conversations and a safe environment for settling disputes, as well as education and training opportunities.

#### **The Project**

Six Rivers Dispute Resolution Center has been selected as one of five community mediation centers from around the nation to participate in a grant-funded pilot project that will develop conflict resolution and leadership skills in young adults (ages 21-35), with a focus on young adults who have experienced marginalization.

#### **Project Advisor Opportunity**

Six Rivers is searching for a **Project Advisor**. This is an opportunity for the Project Advisor to **develop/deepen professional skills in project management, conflict resolution and group facilitation**, and help create positive change in our Gorge community. **This could be a great opportunity for a student and/or someone interested in building skills in the areas of non-profit/social service work, conflict resolution and community organizing.**

- The Project Advisor will provide several hours of service each month, from approximately November 2020 to approximately March 2021. The amount of services provided over this time period will be approximately 40 hours in total and may vary each month.
- The Project Advisor will provide independent contractor services to Six Rivers and will be compensated \$850 total, provided deliverables are met.
- There may be the opportunity for the Project Advisor to continue with the project beyond March of 2021, if interested.
